Eliminating paper routes and making way for a new organics program

With 30 trucks providing residential and commercial services, the Municipality of Anchorage (Alaska) hauls garbage, recycling, glass, organics, and business waste.

Challenge

- Per day, paper-based routes used more than a ream of paper that took half an hour to print
- Paper documents made it difficult to respond quickly to customers and created double data entry
- Inconsistent, incorrect collection data gathered by GPS left office staff unable to verify service

Results

- Digital routing saves paper and time, and allows for other process improvements
- Real-time communication between drivers and office staff improves customer service and documentation — and eliminates duplicative tasks
- Reliable RFID data creates service verification
- Increased efficiency allows a new organics collection program to launch and scale from 120 customers in 2017 to 2,000 in 2021
